Location	Coppermine Place II Apartments Herndon, VA
Position Title	Bread Donation Helper
Purpose	The Panera Day-End Dough-Nation Program provides donated bread and other baked goods to benefit low- to moderate-income older adults and persons with disabilities that face economic and accessibility challenges to food each week. Residents experience reduced household food insecurity, increased access and consumption of baked goods, and reduced household food budgets.
Key Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive at Coppermine Place II Apartments to pick up the bins used for the bread donations • Arrive at the Panera Bread location on Wednesday night at 9:25PM when it closes to pack up 3-4 large bins of bread and pastries (plus additional shopping bags, as needed) and deliver to Coppermine Place II Apartments • Leave bread bins at Coppermine Place II Apartments for storage until the following week's delivery • Secure community room with issued key upon completion of task
Qualifications/Skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of a personal vehicle with capacity to transport up to 4 bins (12-gallon storage bins) • Must have use of personal vehicle with valid auto insurance • Ability to lift bins of baked goods (up to 25lbs.) • Must be reliable and punctual • Must be at least 18 years of age • Must pass a criminal background check
Time Commitment	Every 3 rd week of each month on Wednesday night at 9:25pm for 1 hour
