Through a Public Private Partnership with Fairfax County, Wesley Housing opened doors to The Fallstead at Lewinsville Center, an 82-unit affordable independent-living community for seniors.

Alexandria City Council approved the construction of a new affordable housing project at Fairlington Presbyterian Church, including a \$7,650,000 subordinate loan for the development.

Frederick County Board of Supervisors approved the redevelopment proposal for Senseny Place, a 71-unit affordable housing community for seniors at the site of St. Paul's on-the-Hill Episcopal Church in Winchester, VA.

Wesley Housing acquired its second and third properties in Washington, DC, 1 Hawaii Avenue NE (34 units) and 410 Cedar Street NW (30 units).

Development plans began on The Arden in Alexandria (126 units) and The Cadence in Arlington (97 units).

Renovations began on Brookland Place Apartments in the District (80 units) and Culpepper Garden in Arlington (204 units).

Wexford Manor Apartments was selected as the 2018 Best Large Affordable Housing Project by the Housing Association of Nonprofit Developers.
